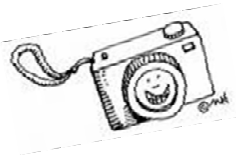

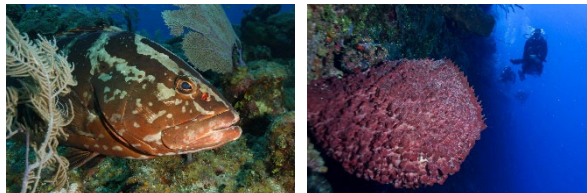

Concierge Diving

You will set up your gear the first time and, from then on, the dive staff will take care of your BCD and reg setup, removal, rinsing and drying. They also have a wetsuit drying area and gear lockers on the dock. Once on the boat, you’ll simply walk back to the dive platform and sit on one of the 2 seats. The staff will bring your BCD rig to you. From there you simply stand up and giant stride into the water. The reverse takes place upon exiting the water. Have a seat, the staff takes your BCD off and you don’t have to stumble back through the boat with your rig on. Now, that’s service!
